Learning at Parikrma is a fun exercise:

An entire classroom becomes a chess/snake & ladder game – with floors painted as a chessboard and another with snakes and ladders. We have science labs that go beyond the usual with specimens and observatories. History classes are never without life-size maps taking kids on journeys to the past. The junior classes are full of toys and props – a perfect set-up for a fun quiz.

Each day, a 45-minute reading session mandates a wide range of fully stocked libraries.

We are currently looking at investing in what we call our "fresh stock of inspiration" - Books (fiction and nonfiction, graphic novels), dictionaries (different languages),

games (indoor and outdoor), updated maps, toys for representation for Mercury classes (Grade 1), and specimens and slides for science labs, among others.
