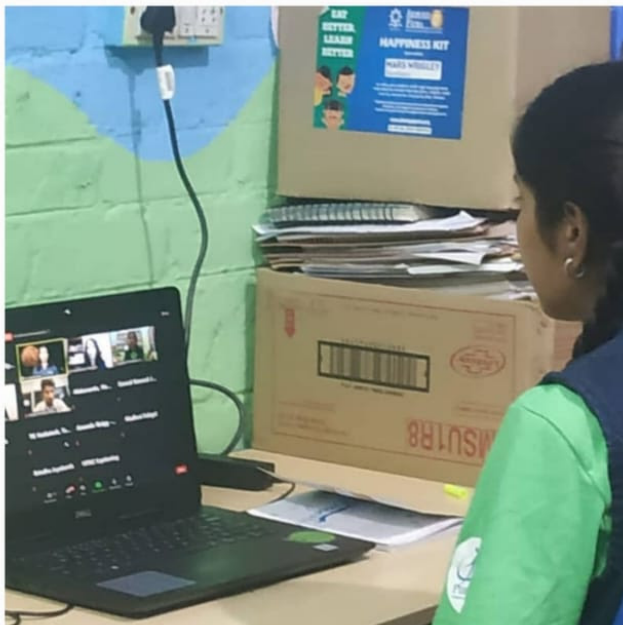

This year has been a year of "outcomes & fulfillment" - our quick action post-COVID-19 and adaptability have allowed us to lead by example.

Summarising 2022 in a few key points:

- Technology in classrooms & beyond: Projectors, live sessions with mentors across the globe, adoption of tech for better governance and data tracking of student performance & family welfare
- Launch of market Readiness Program - mentorship and in-house programs to aid our 12th graders
- Expansion of the Parikrma Inside™ initiative: support to government schools in the city. Inauguration of summer school at two government schools
- Launch of Clinic on Wheels with Indiaassetz - a roaming augmented neo-medical aid to service thousands living in over 110 slums.
- Launch of the decentralised solar energy solutions at Jayanagar school - with Selco Foundation and Wells Fargo

- Our students received an award from the education minister for achieving distinction in their board exams. Two boys and girls from our Football Clubs are selected to represent the State in the Nationals. One of our students has been chosen to attend the student enrichment program at IIT-M.
- Alums: One of our students got into IIM Bangalore, one graduated from National Law School, two opened their own enterprises, and alumna Deepa was invited to attend the Young Leaders Summit at Manchester by Manchester City's Football Academy.
- We are proud to have hosted, with Chiguru CoLab, the 1st Image Reveal by NASA James Webb Telescope - Community Event in Bengaluru.
- Two research papers published covering pressing issues in education and children with suggestions on policy interventions
- Awarded the Great Place to Work™ and one among 75 mid-size India's Best Workplaces for Women™, among the top 10 India's most admired philanthropic schools. Two teachers receive recognition from the State.
- Founder Shukla Bose was awarded Education 2.0 - Outstanding Leadership Award, Dubai and the Bengaluru Women Lifetime Achievement Award.

- A few alumni have started a sports management company called Rapt Sports, and another, having received their B and C certification, has started the Sports Academy in Bengaluru.
- Our alum, Meiraba (taekwondo champion and footballer), has started a fitness studio in Bengaluru.

Support Bengaluru's Girl's Football Club



A few years ago, the Karnataka State Football Association (KSFA) approached Parikrma. Based on the success of our men's Football Club (A-Division), they asked us to consider setting up a Parikrma Women's Football Club. So, in August 2015, the Club was established to provide over 16 girls, former alumni and other women an opportunity to participate in the State Leagues. Today, 6 of our girls have represented the State, and many from the remotest part of the country are members.



The Parikrma Women's FC features our alumni and other girls from similarly underserved families. They all share a common dream of attaining football excellence and Parikrma would like to support that dream. While the team has a great deal of talent, they lack access to both essential equipment and football practice grounds. Thus, we are raising small grants to enable various support systems for the team:



Funds for better gear in the form of football boots, uniforms, footballs, nets and cones: 1 lakh

Higher levels of nutrition – nutritious breakfast after every practice session, nutritional

supplements such as calcium or whey protein: 1 Lakh

Total amount: 2 lakh INR

Your support will give the young girls access to better equipment and resources for regular practice sessions.
