ZERO SUICIDES

When Parikrma began its schools in 2003, one of the critical issues faced was the suicide rates in the slums we work with. **We are proud to say that the number of suicides has decreased to zero** because of our ongoing counselling of students and families, despite the turbulent years we all faced because of the pandemic.

SUCCESS OF NIOS PROGRAM

We launched the NIOS program a couple of years ago for some of our **students who have challenges following the regular curriculum but have extraordinary talent i**n art, music and a few different subjects. We believe that all children have unique skills and should not be straight-jacketed to follow a pattern that discourages them and affects their self-esteem.

Impact: We recently distributed certificates to our students who did amazingly well in the **Board exams with 100 percent pass.**



CLINIC ON WHEELS

IndiaAssetz and the Parikrma Foundation launched Prana – Clinic on Wheels: a primary augmented neomedical aid. The model (with six beds) will serve as a Mobile ICU with oxygen support – the facility has already been used to vaccinate hundreds of children and families from the slums. The mobile clinic will service thousands living in over 110 slums in Bengaluru—a big shout out to Sai Narain and Selco Foundation.

Parikrma School won the championship at the **Ryan International School Minithon**


At the **14th State Level School Olympics**, nine of our students won gold, silver and bronze medals.

Power Play Champions Football Cup: Parikrma reached finals after defeating Sri Lanka in the semis.


ALUM STORIES

ALUMI

- 1349 students graduated from Parikrma since 2008
- 90% of our alumni continue their education post 12th std at Parikrma
- Recent grads (graduated in last 5 years): 70% studying though about a quarter of these are also working; avg annual income 2.4 laks
- Those graduated 5-10 yrs ago: 78% working; 15% studying, typically while also working ; avg annual income 3.7 laks
- Those graduated 10 yrs+ ago: 83% working; 12% studying, typically while also working ; avg annual income 4 laks

Almost all those working are doing so in white collar jobs though difficult to generalize beyond this since the range is huge.


